CAMECO TOUCHDOWN FOR DREAMS APPLICATIONS NOW AVAILABLE

A diagnosis of cancer should not get in the way of women having a dream fulfilled and the Cameco Touchdown for Dreams program is helping make this a reality. The goal of the program is to grant dreams to Saskatchewan women who are living with a life threatening diagnosis of cancer.

The program grants five dreams each year and is a partnership between the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency, Cameco and the Saskatchewan Roughriders. To be eligible for a dream, women must complete an application form and submit it to the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency. Applicants must be at least 19 years of age and a Saskatchewan resident. A maximum of \$5,000 will be provided towards the dream of a woman with a life threatening diagnosis of cancer. All applications for this year must be received by **April 1, 2013**.

"Our patients teach us about humility, hope and faith every day, so to be able to make a dream come true is something we don't take for granted," said Scott Livingstone CEO of the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency. "Working together with Cameco and the Saskatchewan Roughriders we are able to make a difference in the life of a woman with cancer and we encourage individuals to consider applying to the program."
