CAMECO TOUCHDOWN FOR DREAMS APPLICATIONS NOW AVAILABLE

Cameco and the Saskatchewan Roughriders have teamed up with the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency for a third year to present Cameco Touchdown for Dreams. Since 2012, the program has worked to make a difference in the lives of women facing a life-threatening diagnosis of cancer by granting them a dream.

The Saskatchewan Cancer Agency has begun accepting applications for dream fulfillment. To be eligible, women must complete an application form and submit it to the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency. Applicants must be at least 19 years of age and a Saskatchewan resident. A maximum of \$5,000 will be provided towards the dream of a woman with a life-threatening diagnosis of cancer. All applications must be received by **April 1, 2014**.

"Seeing these women, who are facing such tremendous adversity, experience the joy of having a dream is a true honour," said Scott Livingstone, CEO of the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency. "It is a privilege to be able to play even a small part in the lives of these remarkable women."
